



## FCS Golf Challenge at King's Creek Golf Club, Spring Hill, TN

Dear FCS Family:

As a member of the FCS family, I would like to invite you to join me in sharing the unique story of FCS while raising significant funds for the school. On Friday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>, FCS will host a Golf Challenge at King's Creek Golf Club in Spring Hill. The Golf Challenge is a vehicle through which players and non-players can "raise funds and find friends" to support the FCS Scholarship Fund, FCS Fine Arts and Athletics, and the FCS Capital Campaign.

How do we do this? We do this by recruiting captains and players who will commit to mailing a sponsorship letter and a FCS flyer to at least 50 people. A sample letter, to mail or to email to family, friends, coworkers and acquaintances will be provided along with FCS flyers.

Not everyone is a golfer, but you can participate in this exciting endeavor as part of a team. As a Team Captain (you do not have to be a golfer to do this), your commitment would be:

1. **To recruit 3 more players** for your team. If you are not a golfer, recruit 4 players and you become the non-playing captain of the team and the 5<sup>th</sup> fund raiser of the team. You can also recruit as many non-playing, fundraising team members as you would like to support your 4 playing golfers.
2. **To explain** to your team the importance of **the unique fundraising process** and the long term value of finding friends as well as raising funds for FCS. ALL the materials you need will be provided to each player at the Captain's meeting.
3. To attend the **Captains' meeting on Friday, 12 February from 7:00-8:00 a.m. at the Brentwood Country Club.**
4. To bring your team members and their spouses to a **Special Tee-Off Event on Tuesday, 23 March from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. at a location to be announced.**
5. Come join us at the 1:00 pm Shotgun start for the **FCS Golf Challenge on Friday, 23 April 2010.**

I know you receive numerous requests for your time and resources, but I want to thank you for considering the FCS Golf Challenge and joining us as a captain, a non-playing captain or as an individual player. I would be happy to include you as a part of another team if you can not be a captain.
