### **Fact or Fallacy: Using Logic to Search Out & Defend Truth (Monday, September 14, 21, and 28)**

Develop critical thinking skills by learning to detect fallacies, whether in advertising, debates, political campaigns, or other venues of persuasion. This workshop's creative, hands-on approach will make learning logic both fun and practical.
